According to an article online, "Bandura's Social Learning Theory points that people learn from one another, via observation, imitation, and modeling. Not only that, if the people that surround these kids respond to the behavior it has a reward or punishment. Meaning for example if a child is playing with a stuff animal and does not try to rip its head off then this is a rewarding behavior that will most likely be repeated and this has been reinforced. Mcleod state, "Reinforcement can be external or internal and can be positive or negative. If a child wants approval from parents or peers, this approval is an external reinforcement, but

feeling happy about being approved of is an internal reinforcement" (Mcleod). This can go both ways because adults and children have what is called vicarious reinforcement. Meaning they can observed the consequences of another behavior and repeat it. It can be a younger or older sibling who's the role model. Take the example Badura gives us in the article where the more big stars smoke in the media screen, the more popular smoking become among the population. ### School shooting in Parkland, Florida

2018 started off with tons of violence that involve many young kids. Within the past month there has been attempts of school shooting. Many have failed but some succeed in taking innocent lives. One in particular happened at a high school in Parkland, Florida where 17 were killed. A teen gunman opened fired with a semi-automatic rifle at his former high school. He has been charged with 17 counts of murder on Thursday. The suspect was later identified as Nikolas Cruz who was 19 years old. With 17 dead there was at least 14 other wounded and five with life threatening injures. NBC News were told that Cruz had been expelled form Douglas for disciplinary and was enrolled elsewhere in the district. The FBI was alerted six month ago of the youtuber comment about the school shooting, but they chose to do nothing. However, Cruz mother died early November which lead Cruz to stay with local family. The local family that Cruz were staying with says he has been living with them for three months with no concerns or issues. However, an article published by Elizabeth on NBC state that Brandon Minoff had classes with Cruz. A fellow classmate said, "I got paired with him for a project, and he started talking to me about his life — how he was held back twice, expelled from two private schools.

He likes to do reckless stuff," Minoff said. He had aspirations to join the military," Minoff said. He enjoyed hunting" (Chuk, 2018). So, after losing his mother there was some issue going on with him that was not discussed openly. This is because another senor said there was something wrong about Cruz. The superintendent said there are at least two police cars on campus on a daily basis but not on the day of the shooting. After the shooting had been under control several students began to share their stories on what happened that day. Where many say the school had gone through a fire drill earlier in the day. There were many parents who were relieved to see their kids running to their arms for safety.

There were countless ways in which the media reacted to this horrific event. There were many interviews of the FBI on the shooter. Who made a comment on a YouTube video in late 2017 saying "I will become a professional school shooter". Which they were able to link back to the person who left the comment which was Nikolas Cruz. Unfortunately, they already knew this six months ago. There was also another video interview of cops speaking on the shooter that visited the gun range on the morning of the actual shooting. There was cover of this event on every new channel including Broward County Sheriff officer setting up a news conference shortly after the shooting. Also, the president Donald Trump tweeted that there were many signs that the Florida shooter was mentally corrupt. That he will address the nation shortly. There was also a 30 second video of the cops tazing Cruz and arresting him after the school shooting. Furthermore, there was a close up of his picture to show the world who this guy is. Rick Scott Florida governor say this is just pure evil. This is because he makes the statement that this state is all about protecting children's and does not tolerate violence. There was also another video on NBC New website with montage of students who capture this horrible moment on their smartphones. We can hear the shots going off in the background as students were terrified. Alone elementary, middle, and high school since the beginning of 2018 has a total of 24 people being killed and more then 40 being injured in these school shootings. Social media blew up due to the school shooting. This lead to students, teachers, and the world to start a movement of stopping gun violence. There are many famous celebrities and athletes who are willing to jump in with these students to fight for school safety. Which all leads to the social learning theory of people having influence and adapting to other behaviors.
